HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

Twenty fifth of July 1968 was a landmark in the history of Madurai Muslims; Muqyyath Sha Sirguro Wakf Board College came into being at a time when education at the collegiate level was inaccessible to the downtrodden and the less fortunate of the students who had neither means nor clout to pull enough strings to gain access into college. Muqyyath Sha Sirguro Wakf Board College was a God-send, answer to their prayers.

In 1967, a dispute between Janab. Isthiak Sha Sahib Sirguro and the TamilNadu Wakf Board over a stretch of valuable property were resolved under a compromise decree passed by the Madras High Court in A.S.No.435 of 1964 and it was decided to set up a college in the city of Madurai. Honourable Kadayanallur Abdul Mazith Sahib, then the Minister for Local Administration has sown the seeds for starting the college by allotting the necessary funds for land acquisition and by extending unstinted support.

Fully realizing the need of the hour, Janab. M.Heera Sahib and Janab. M. Abdul Khadar Sahib, the two dynamic social workers and indefatigable campaigners for higher education, plunged themselves into the task of transforming the vision of starting a college into a reality. Their steadfast determination and relentless pursuit resulted in the establishment of the college in a rented building at 5, Hakim Ajmal Khan Road, Madurai, under the name of "Muqyyath Sha Sirguro Wakf Board College".

The history of the college is a never-ending saga of the constancy and industry of many illustrious personalities. This galaxy is constituted of the following personalities whose involvement, being substantial and redolent of the spontaneity of their heart and the sagacity of their mind.

Janab.M. Heera Sahib and Janab. M. Abdul Khader Sahib mooted the idea of starting the college and spearheaded it into a historic success. While Janab. H.K. Ghazi, I.A.S., and Janab. A.M. Nabi, I.A.S., extended their official patronage, Janab. F. Ahamed, then the Secretary to the Wakf Board strove his best to speedup the procedural process. The role of the Wakf Board in the establishment of the college is inestimable.

The Government of Tamil Nadu assigned a vast stretch of valuable land of 28 acres at K.K.Nagar, Madurai. Local philanthropists, men of vision and resourcefulness ceaselessly endeavoured for the growth and development of this college through their sacrifices. Their dynamism enabled the collection of a sizeable sum towards the building fund.

It is the only college in India that enjoys the exclusiveness of privilege to be run under the auspices of a State Wakf Board. The college, though a minority institution is secular in outlook and admits to its fold, students of all communities. There has been an appreciable improvement in the excellence of coaching and the conscientiousness of the staff. It is a matter of pride to note that many a personality from Madurai has contributed his might to the college and they deserve our enduring appreciation and gratitude.

The college has registered a steady progress over the years. B.A. Economics (both English and Tamil Medium), B.A. History and B.Com, Courses were started in quick succession.

Consequently, upon the introduction of plus two pattern of education, the college got affiliation for B.Sc., Chemistry and Zoology in June, 1979 after developing the necessary

infrastructure. The college has been offering M.A. English Language and Literature since 1980 and B.Sc. Maths since 1982 and B.Sc. Physics since 1984, and M.Com. since 1987 and B.Sc., Computer Science since 1992 and B.Sc. Electronics. B.Sc. Microbiology, B.B.A. and M.Sc. Computer Science course were started during 1998. B.Com. Computer Applications was started in 1999 and M.S. Information Technology and Management were started in 2000. From the academic year 1994-95 onwards, the college offers Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications, B.A., English Literature and M.Com. (C.A) were started in 2011-12. In 1981 a new block was inaugurated on the western side of the main block. Foundation stone for the hostel building was laid by Janab. B.S.A. Rahman on 26.02.1984 and the construction work commenced. The Hostel was inaugurated on 05.10.1986.

PG Diploma in Management, B.C.A, B.A Tamil and B.Sc. Mathematics with CA were started from the academic year 2018-2019. In the same year the Department of English was upgraded as a Research Centre.

The college Conference Hall was inaugurated and foundation stone for the UGC blocks was laid in 1991. Subsequently, the construction of the blocks was completed.

The college library is equipped with more than 39,874 volumes to meet the intellectual requirements of the students and the staff. The academic progress of the college has shown a marked improvement over the years. Our athletes and sportsmen have carved a niche for themselves in the sports history of Madurai Kamaraj University.

FEE COLLECTION

1. The students must pay the fees before the due date. Due date will be announced through the circular. If a student fails to pay the fees on or before the due date his name will be removed from the college register. Payment of fee after due date is subject to a fine of Re.1 for every day after the deadline.
2. Fees will be collected during the prescribed timing only.
3. The students should immediately obtain the receipts (officials) printed and signed or all the payment they make and preserve them carefully for further reference.
4. Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances or adjusted on any account. If a student leaves the college at any time after admission, he cannot claim refund or part of the fees paid. If he leaves the college in the middle of any semester, he shall be liable to pay the entire fees for each semester till his name is on the college rolls. Unless such dues repaid, no certificate will be issued.

GENERAL CONDUCT OF STUDENTS

1. The students shall be in their classes before the ringing of the second bell, when a teacher enters the class room the students shall rise, remain standing till he takes his seat or asks them to sit.
2. No student shall leave the class room without permission or until the teacher has left.
3. Students are required to spend their leisure hours in the library they shall not loiter about either on the verandas or inside the college campus or disturb the classes at work.

4. The students shall preserve cleanliness of the buildings, furniture and grounds. They shall not deface the walls or any part of the college premises or damage any furniture. If any damage is caused, suitable fine will be levied. If the responsibility for the damage cannot be fixed on any individual student, the cost of the damage will be recovered from all the students by an imposition of collective fine.
5. Students are expected to read the college notice board and the development notice boards.
6. The students should not hold meetings or circulate any notice or stick notices of any kind without the previous permission of the Principal.
7. No student of this college shall be a member of any association unconnected with this college without the previous permission of the Principal. They shall not take part in any anti-social or subversive activities.
8. Any lost property found must be handed over to the office. The owner can claim it promptly after proving his ownership with a written declaration.
9. No Student shall smoke inside the class room or within the College Campus.
10. Disobedience and attempt at copying in examination shall be dealt with severely.
11. No student shall enter the college campus under the influence of drug or alcoholic drinks.
12. All two wheelers must be parked only in the cycle stand maintained by the contractor.

13. Under the education rules of the Government, the Principal has full power to inflict the following punishments such as fine, withholding of certificates, suspension and expulsion from the college.

LABORATORY RULES

1. Laboratory work shall be assessed continuously in every practical class.
2. Record notebook and observation note books shall be maintained and produced during the University External Practical examination.
3. Students breaking any article or apparatus through carelessness or negligence will be required to pay its cost at current market price. In this matter the decision of the Head of the Department shall be final.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE RULES

1. Punctual and regular attendance for classes is required.
2. Students shall assemble in their respective lecture rooms before the second bell.
3. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each period. Those who come late will not be allowed inside the class.
4. A student who continuously absents himself for 15 days without letter will have his name struck off from the rolls.
5. Absence from Tests will be seriously viewed. Action will be taken by the Head of the Department concerned. Chronic absentees will be dealt with by the Discipline Committee.
6. Leave cannot be granted during the period of Tests and Examination.

7. Leave must be applied for in advance. In a leave application reason for leave must clearly be stated. Leave applications must be countersigned by parent or guardian.
8. In case of extending leave beyond three days, the Principal may require the production of medical or other certificates.
9. Absconders from classes and habitual absentees shall be dealt with severely. The punishment ranges from suspension to removal from the college.
10. a) Students are required to have at least 75% of attendance to appear for the university examination.
b) If a student has 65% to 74% of attendance, he/she should pay a fee Rs.360 to the University and apply for condonation.
c) If a student has 50% to 64% of attendance, he could sit for university examination only after paying Rs.600/- to the university and obtaining a special permission from the university. But he/she will be permitted to take his/her arrear paper only.
d) If a student has put in attendance of below 50%, he/she will have to repeat the Semester.

The students must apply for any certificates only in the prescribed form given in the following page. The students should give a prior notice of 48 hours.

Majlis - E- Deeniyyath provides religious and normal instructions to all Muslim students. The Diniyyath course aims at making the Muslim students understand and follow the fundamental principles of Islam. It teaches practical method of Islamic culture.

Classes under the auspices of Majlis - E - Deeniyyath will be conducted everyweek for both Regular and Self-financed course students. Attendance for Muslim students is compulsory. Absentees will lose half day attendance.

NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC)

National Cadet Corps is primarily a youth organization of our country which came into existence by an Act of parliament in the year 1948. This functions directly under the Ministry of Defence and is supported by the State Government.

The aims of NCC are:

a) To develop qualities of character, courage, comradeship, discipline, leadership, secular outlook, spirit of adventure and sportsmanship and the ideals of selfless service among the youth to make them useful citizen.

b) To create human resources of organized, trained and motivated youth to provide leadership in all walks of life including the Armed Forces and always available for the service of the nation.

c) To create a suitable environment to motivate the youth to take up a career in the Armed Forces.

We have NCC Army wing in the college with 102 cadets, (Boys and Girls) known as C-8 Company affiliated to 7 (TN) Bn, under Madurai Group. Both boys and girls can join NCC and continue to remain cadets for 3 years.

The cadets are trained in Drill, Weapon training, Map Reading, and Field craft. Opportunities are available for eligible cadets to attend camps including the Republic Day camp, Army Attachments, Mountaineering courses, Trekking Expeditions, Para Jumping, National Integration Camp, Cycle-Expeditions and the like.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

Overall Objectives:

Service to the community, offered while undergoing instruction in an educational institution.

- * To arouse the social consciousness of students.
- * To provide them with an opportunity to work with the people around the education campus creatively and constructively.
- * To put the education, they receive to concrete social use.

Special Objectives:

- * To engage in creative and constructive social vocation.
- * To gain skills in the exercise of democratic leadership.

Certificate:

Each N.S.S. Volunteer is expected to do 120 **hours of service in every academic** year. On completion of two years, on the basis of nominal roll and diary of the students, the University will issue them certificates.

Recognition:

As a mark of recognition of National Service Scheme service by students **5% additional marks may be given** to the best N.S.S. Volunteer for admission to professional, Institutions such as Medical Colleges, Engineering Colleges and the like.

Enrollment:

There are four NSS units (22, 23, 24, 25) in our college and each unit has hundred volunteers.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The college offers enormous scope for the students who are interested in athletics and other related sports activities.

Special coaching will be provided for promising athletes and players for inter - collegiate sports and games by the Physical Director and his dedicated team of staff.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The College Union along with the other Associations conducts the co-curricular activities of the college. All students are members of the College Union.

The principal is the Ex-Officio President of all the Associations and he nominates a Vice-President for each Association among the members of the teaching faculty.

Each Association has its own budget. The Vice-president is responsible for the expenditure and proper maintenance of accounts. The statements of expense together with proper voucher for advance taken shall be furnished to the College Office within two weeks after withdrawal of funds.

The students' representative shall follow the instructions given by the Vice president of the Association concerned. They shall be responsible for maintaining the dignity and decorum during the functions and meetings.

The student's representative shall consult the Vice-president of the Association concerned before fixing up a chief guest or a star speaker.
